


Transmission

WHO classification: Sporadic cases. Note: All cases reported from March 19th to April 18th were international travel associated, or epidemiologically linked to international travel associated cases in the community. There were 0 cases reported from April 19th to July 5th. Cases from July 6th to date were international travel associated - detected while undergoing mandatory 14 day quarantine in government designated international border quarantine facilities in Nadi.*


