

*2 border cases recorded in week of November 30-December 6th were crew of the international cargo vessel MV Island Chief, which had docked at the Lautoka and Suva ports after arriving from New Zealand, via Nukualofa, Tonga – none of the crew disembarked in Fiji. **Prior to January 15th 2021 all laboratory testing for the virus that causes COVID-19 occurred at Fiji CDC (using mainly RT-PCR with some Cepheid Xpert Xpress testing). Therefore, all test data was sourced from Fiji CDC. From January 15th 2021, testing using Cepheid Xpert Xpress began at Lautoka hospital, followed by Labasa hospital, and CWM Hospital in Suva. Due to a delay in reporting of negative test data from these labs to Fiji CDC, the testing numbers listed in the COVID-19 Updates since January 15th 2021 may be an undercount of actual daily/weekly tests. Note that any positive tests will be notified immediately. Once negative test data from the 3 divisional labs are received, subsequent COVID-19 Updates, and the test tables and graphs on the website, are updated accordingly.

***The government designated international border quarantine facilities are located in Nadi, therefore border quarantine cases are almost exclusively reported from Nadi. This explains the disproportionately high number of cases recorded for Nadi compared to other locations.
