ZIKA VIRUS IS NOT A THREAT IN FIJI

In response to misleading media reports, the Health Ministry would like to clarify that

the Zika virus disease is currently **not** a public health threat in Fiji.

The Ministry conducts regular surveillance, which includes laboratory testing, for Zika

virus disease in Fiji with confirmatory testing done in the country at the National

Public Health Laboratory. In 2017, there was one confirmed case detected. However,

there has **never** been a reported case of Zika virus disease related complications in

pregnancy (e.g. microcephaly) in Fiji. The Ministry continues to be vigilant in our

surveillance for Zika virus and other mosquito-borne diseases.

We continue to encourage all Fijians and visitors to protect themselves from mosquito

bites, which includes using DEET containing mosquito repellant.
