

Screening Clinic Services

The Ministry of Health and Medical Services is targeting COVID-19 testing for individuals in high risk groups. This is to identify and treat those at risk of severe illness from COVID-19 and to prevent further hospitalisations and deaths.

If you, or someone you are caring for has mild COVID — 19 symptoms (cough, runny nose, nasal congestion, sneezing, fatigue, headache, aches and pains, sore throat, fever, diarrhoea, red eyes, loss of taste or smell)

AND

- over 50 years of age
- or have existing illness such as diabetes, heart disease, kidney disease, asthma, are obese
- or are pregnant

Please visit a screening clinic and get tested. If you test positive, then we will ensure you are provided immediate care by our health teams.

NOTE: If you experience mild symptoms and do not fall into any of the groups above, you do not need to be tested. Most people infected with COVID-19 will have mild symptoms and will fully recover at home with no medical intervention necessary. Please immediately isolate yourselves from others including your family members and monitor your symptoms. Should you begin to experience severe COVID-19 symptoms, go immediately to one of our dedicated health facilities.

For symptomatic workers who need official leave from work, they are recommended to attend the nearest screening clinic to be checked and obtain a medical certificate for 14 days of self-isolation at home.

Symptomatic workers can also obtain a medical certificate for the 14 days self-isolation at home, from participating General Practitioners (GPs).
