Domestic Travel

As of 12 November 2021, protocols for travel within Fiji

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Registration and travel pass no longer required for domestic travel.
- Quarantine-free domestic travel, except for red zone* areas/villages, communities.
- Only fully vaccinated persons can travel.
- Passenger capacity on shipping vessels will be restricted to 50%.
- Measures will be taken to ensure that all COVID-19 safe measures are stringently enforced during boarding, transit, and while disembarking. All shipping companies must have a symptoms and temperature surveillance and a program of surveillance testing approved by MHMS

RETURNING RESIDENTS FROM OVERSEAS

- Travelers must spend three days on a hotel premises in Fiji
- A negative COVID-19 test will allow travelers to enter Fijian communities in any location

SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR TRAVEL TO RED ZONE AREAS/VILLAGES/COMMUNITIES WITH LESS THAN 60% VACCINATION COVERAGE

International tourists

Red zone areas, villages, and communities in any location in Fiji are NO GO ZONES for international tourists.

Returning residents (both overseas and local)

On arrival at the red zone area/villages or communities, particularly in the Northern Division and maritime islands, **ALL** travelers will enter into a 7-day quarantine* period at their place of residence. This requirement is to help protect these communities from any possible COVID-19 infection.

NOTE: The advice above will be amended as vaccine coverage milestones are achieved in these areas, villages and communities.

*GUIDELINES FOR THE 7-DAY QUARANTINE PERIOD IN A RED ZONE AREA

- a. A person under quarantine should stay in their home and have contact with as few people as possible.
- b. Quarantined individuals must not leave their home at all during the 7-day quarantine period except for a medical emergency.
- c. Quarantined individual must not attend school or work with other people.
- d. Quarantined individual must not attend any gatherings, whether it concerns their work, family or social life.
- e. Quarantined individuals should not entertain guests in the home during quarantine.
- f. Quarantined individuals can go out to a balcony or a private garden. If there are other people there, quarantined individuals must maintain 2 meters distancing and ensure they are wearing a mask.
- g. Quarantine individual must not share items with family members and should refrain from consuming kava and alcohol during the quarantine period.
- h. Quarantine individual should launder his/her clothing separately from other family members and sanitize all contact surfaces used during and after the process.
