HOSPITAL VISITATION PROCESS AT CWM HOSPITAL POST-COVID-19.

All visitors and patients to the CWM Hospital are advised to take note of the following measures for the safety of the hospital in-patients, relatives, hospital staff and the general public.

It is very important that the public understand that the hospital is a very high risk area and that the in-patients are a vulnerable group in our population. These measures will ensure that the COVID risk within the hospital is reduced.

1. HOSPITAL VISITING HOURS

1.1 New visiting hours for the general adult wards.

2. VISITORS CHECK-IN

- 2.1 All visitors are required to check-in with the Security before entry to the wards
- 2.2 All visitors must be fully vaccinated and will be required to show proof of vaccination
- 2.3 Visitors should also present a photo ID – Driving license, Joint card or Voter ID

3. PATIENT CAREGIVERS

- 3.1 Only one visitor will be allowed per patient
- 3.2 Visiting in the ward will be carried out by sections to avoid overcrowding in the hospital
- 3.3 Caregivers can now be rotated if the family wishes, as long as they fulfill the requirements under the Caregivers Standard Operating Procedures. Further information on the requirements can be obtained from health staff at the Ward Desks.
- 3.4 Hospital reserves the right to disallow a caregiver or visitor if they pose a risk of COVID in the hospital

4. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES

- 4.1 **Family Conference – 8:00am – 10:00am**
- 4.2 **Chaplaincy and religious visitors – 5:00pm – 6:00pm**
 - a. They will be required to apply and register with the CWM Hospital Administration
- 4.3 **Children** – the visiting hours will commence on 1st March 2022
- 4.4 **Maternity** – special consideration will be given to family members on a case by case basis.
- 4.5 **ICU, ED and critical case** – the Nurse Unit manager for each ward will provide guidance to the visitors
