Provisional Registration - FAQ

1. What products need to be listed.

S2, S3, S4 and Schedule 1 medicines that are not complementary medicines (i.e. Paracetamol and Anatacids)

- 2. What business types can list products in the provisional register? Any company importing medicines into Fiji. This includes wholesalers, pharmacies, retailers and supermarkets.
- 3. Who is responsible for listing their products on the provisional register? The company importing the medicine into Fiji. Companies purchasing medicines from a wholesaler that have already listed the products do not need to list the products.
- 4. What if the same product is being imported by another company? Both companies must list the product in their provisional register to ensure the Fiji MRA has an understanding of all products that are being imported into Fiji at this time.
- 5. How does the provisional register differ from product registration? The provisional register is a tool to collect information about medicines being imported into Fiji. The register will be used to inform and support the upcoming product registration activities.

Medicines listed in the provisional register have not been assessed in regard to safety, efficacy or quality.
